LUTHERAN EDUCATION ASSISTANCE ENDOWMENT (LEAF)

The Lutheran Education Assistance Endowment (LEAF) continues to support families within BSLC who desire a Christ-centered education for their children. All BSLC members already receive a \$1,500 tuition subsidy to attend LCMS K-12 schools in the Kansas City area, but LEAF provides additional, need-based financial assistance to help make enrollment even more accessible.

Established by BSLC members for BSLC families, LEAF exists to ensure that financial barriers don't stand in the way of a Lutheran education. Applications are now open for the 2026–2027 school year, offering support beyond the standard subsidy for qualifying need based families.

Those interested in applying should contact a member of the LEAF Board—Pastor Schultz, George Ledgerwood, Brian Olson, or Trenton Travis by May 15.

The ministry also welcomes donations to grow the endowment and expand its impact. Contributions can be made using the yellow offering envelopes. Make sure to note on the envelope and check "For LEAF Endowment."

JESUS NOT ONLY WANTS US TO BE HIS DISCIPLES, HE TELLS US TO GO AND MAKE DISCIPLES.


