- The first will be held May 6th at Beautiful Savior Lutheran Church in Olathe Kansas from 10 AM till 1PM.

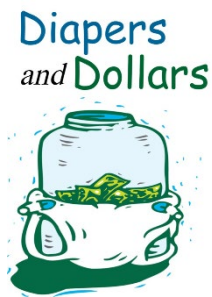
