LUTHERAN EDUCATION ASSISTANCE ENDOWMENT (LEAF)

The Lutheran Education Assistance Endowment (LEAF) continues to support families within BSLC who desire a Christ-centered education for their children.

All BSCL members already receive a \$1,500 tuition subsidy to attend LCMS K–12 schools in the Kansas City area, but LEAF provides additional, need-based financial assistance to help make enrollment even more accessible.

Established by BSCL members for BSCL families, LEAF exists to ensure that financial barriers don't stand in the way of a Lutheran education. Applications are now open for the 2026–2027 school year, offering support beyond the standard subsidy for qualifying need based families.

The ministry also welcomes donations to grow the endowment and expand its impact. Contributions can be made using the yellow offering envelopes. Make sure to note on the envelope and check "For LEAF Endowment."
