HVAC CONGREGATION UPDATE #19

Completed Week of April 21st:

- The landscaping contractor completed their work for the project.
- The sound panel layout drawings were reviewed and approved. The panels will go into production on Monday, April 28th.
- A meeting was held on Friday, April 25th with the panel installation contractor to review and start planning for the sound panel installation.

Completed Week of April 28th:

 The City of Olathe did the inspection on the landscaping portion of the project and three issues have to be addressed. We will provide a picture when we get these items completed and they will do the final sign off on the landscaping.

- The sound panels were discussed with the City of Olathe and once we provide the sound readings after the panel installation, no further city inspections should be required.
- The sound panel manufacturer had a production line equipment issue that introduced some delays in the delivery. We are expecting all panels to be delivered in the first two weeks of June with installation commencing as soon as possible after on-site delivery.
- The cost of unloading the panels and installing them is currently quoted below our budgeted amount.


