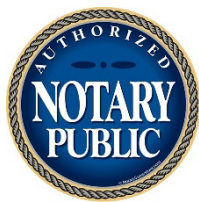

The Kansas District Older Adult Committee is planning 2 additional dedicated events this year which will be spread out across the state.

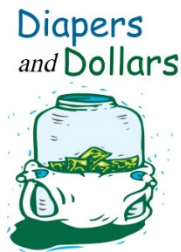

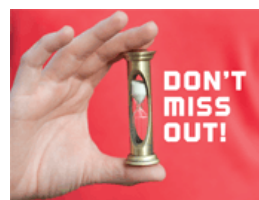
MAY FIELDSTONE FOOD DISTRIBUTION

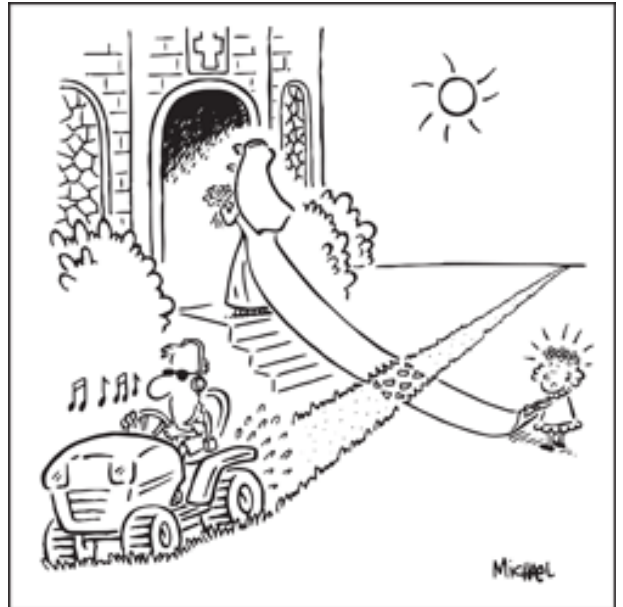

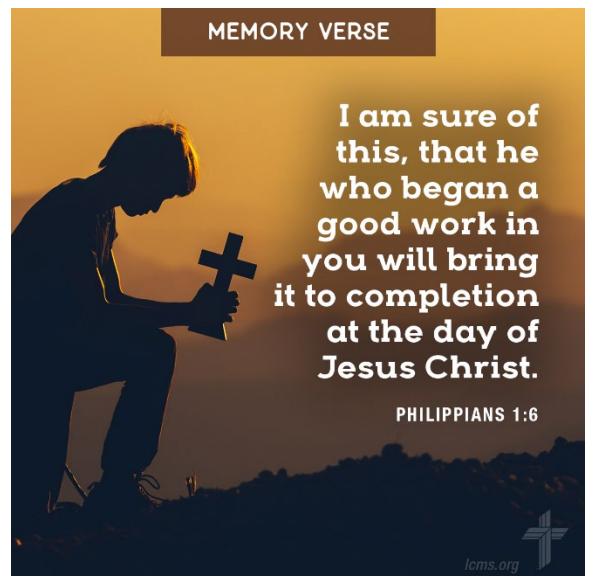
