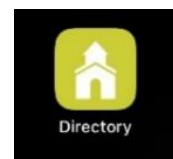

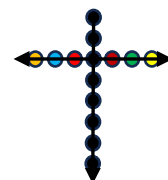

END OF YEAR

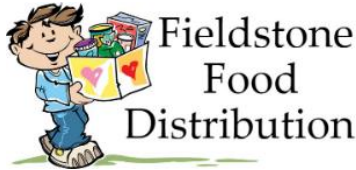

FAITHFUL GIVING IS MERELY RETURNING TO GOD WHAT HE HAS ALREADY GIVEN TO US.

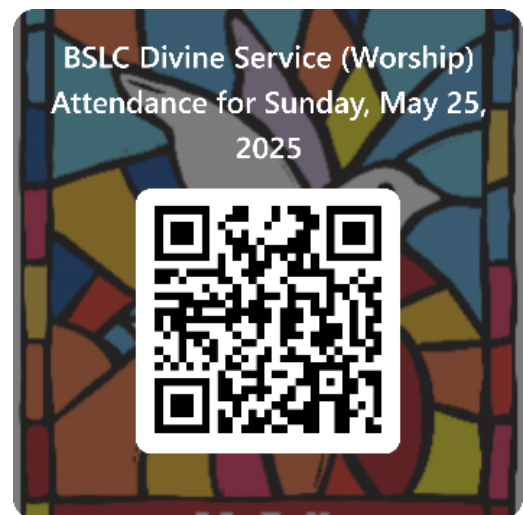

My vicarage assignment is with Our Savior in Baraboo and Trinity Lutheran in Wisconsin Dells in the South Wisconsin District. Firstly, I will get to experience a dual parish ministry which is something that I have been interested in since I started seminary. Secondly, both churches have different congregation sizes, so I will get two different perspectives on ministry. But before I can fully think about vicarage, I have 2 more weeks of classes this semester. All of my classes are starting to look towards the end of the semester, and when I look back at the beginning of the semester, I think this has been one of the most formative semesters I have had here at the seminary. All of the classes have given me practical advice on being a pastor while pushing me to go deeper in my education.

Elise is still working at Accenture as a Software Designer. We think the plan is for her to continue working while on Vicarage, but ultimately that is up to Accenture because she is slightly out of range. We ask for your prayers that God's will may be done and that His plan may be revealed to us as we prepare to head to Wisconsin.

Finally, Annette is now 9 months old. Where has the time gone? She loves to smile and roll around, especially when she is laying down with Dad (she has just learned that she can just roll off of me and onto the bed when I am holding her). We are thankful for the seminary community that has made this first year so much easier for our life as a family. We also want to thank you for your prayers and support this year.
