STEWARDSHIP CORNER

Through the Parable of the Rich Fool (Luke 12:13-21), Jesus illustrates the foolishness of living only for ourselves. Jesus tells about a wealthy and successful farmer who needed to build bigger barns to hold his abundant crops. The farmer was interested only in his own pleasure and well-being. His goal was to become wealthy so he could eat, drink, and be merry during his retirement. He didn't acknowledge God as the

provider of what he had. Because of his self-centered attitude, Jesus calls Him a fool. St. Augustine wrote, "The beginning of all sin is the love of one's own self." By the power of the Holy Spirit, self-love is replaced by love for others, and we learn to focus more on the eternal than the temporal.
