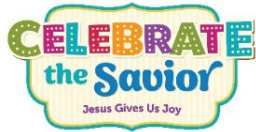

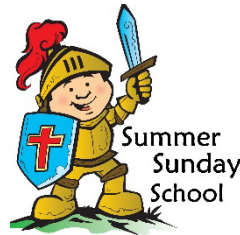
HOSTS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS LHSKC

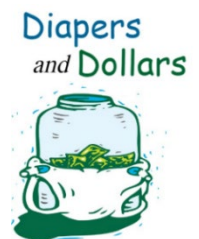

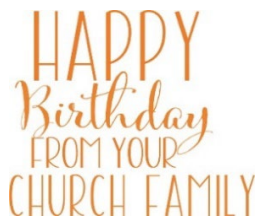
