HVAC CONGREGATION UPDATE #21

Work completed the week of May 26:

- The Sound Panels arrived and were unloaded on Tuesday, May 27.
- The installation contractor started installation of the sound panels on Tuesday, May 27. They completed installation of sound panels on the north, west, and east walls (except the door).
 They are currently installing panels on the south wall. Since we are mounting against the existing

exterior wall system (EIFS) we have a modified fastening process which significantly increases installation time but securely fastens the panels to the wall.

Work scheduled for the week of June 2:

- The landscaping contractor will install remaining trees to address the issue identified during the City of Olathe inspection. We will notify the city when we are complete via text and pictures as agreed upon.
- The concrete contractor will be on site to replace the sidewalk sections damaged during construction.
- The sound panels installation contractor will continue to install and complete installation of the sound panels.
- We will tentatively schedule sound testing for Monday, June 7 with Air Tech and Avant Acoustics. Once we have this done, we will submit for our Permanent Occupancy Permit.


