WEEDING VOLUNTEERS

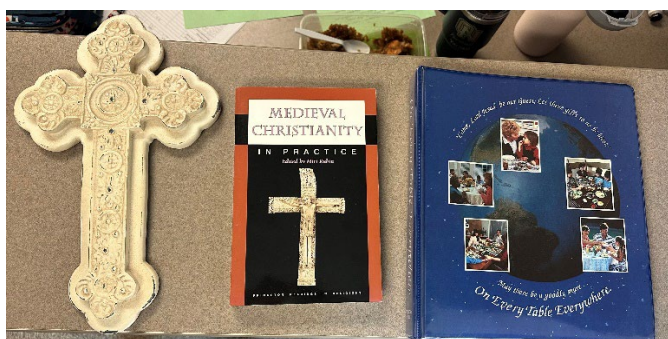


Seeking volunteers to help keep our grounds looking nice. To do that, we need to control the weeds. The grassy areas will be treated and cared for by the mower
