- The contractor completed installation of all sound panels.

Our church family and our neighboring community went above and beyond to support the urgent mission of the Red Cross this summer! Congratulations to all on a job well done!

We not only met, but surpassed our unit donation goal at 53 units! Because of your generosity, our Family of Faith Night will be receiving a check from the Red Cross Community Club Program for \$530!

Here are a few statistics from Sunday's drive:

• 53 units were collected from a total of 48 donors.

- 8 were first time donors and 13 were walkin donors.
- 22 units came from 11 Power Red Donors. (The Red Cross currently accepts urgently needed blood types of O+, O-, A-, and Bfor Power Red donations.)
