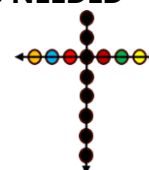

JULY FIELDSTONE FOOD DISTRIBUTION

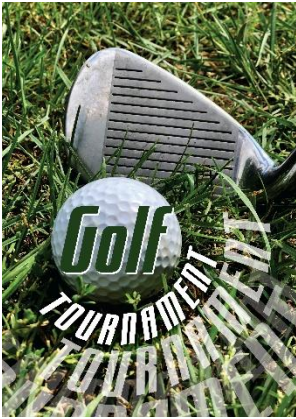
