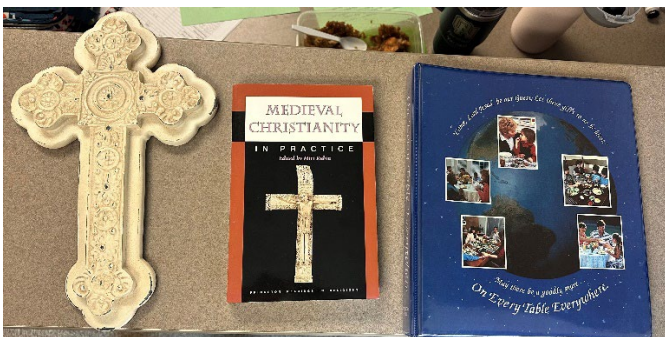


MISSION HVAC MEDIATION
