SUMMER SUNDAY SCHOOL



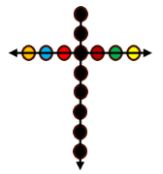

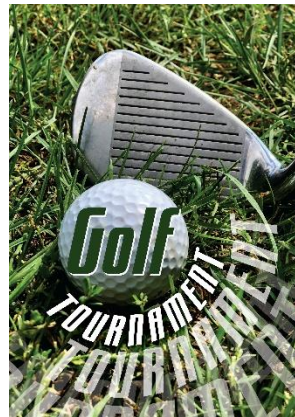
JULY FIELDSTONE FOOD DISTRIBUTION
