



## **RED CROSS BLOOD DRIVE RESULTS**

The Health Ministry Board is excited to share the results of our last blood drive. BSLC made a valiant effort to reach our goal, during the most difficult time of the year to collect blood, and we were so close! We were only 1 short of our donor goal of 35. As is typical with blood drives, there are donors that are deferred from giving blood for multiple reasons and some pints of blood do not meet the standards to be used. We finished with 31 pints of blood and every unit counts as the Red Cross is in a severe hospital blood shortage.

Some other statistics to share:

- BSLC consistently enrolls an above average percentage of first-time donors. This helps to build a base of frequent donors from our church family and a creates a rewarding activity for families to do together (16 yrs. old with parental permission).
- BSLC continues to add Power Red donors at each drive. In June, 7 Power Red donors counted for double units towards our goal.
- BSLC saw more walk-in donors at this event than any previous drives with a total of 10 walk-in donors!

### **STEWARDSHIP CORNER**


