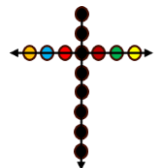
### SUMMER SUNDAY SCHOOL

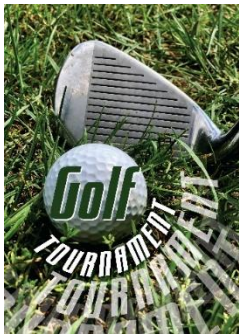
