SCHOOL SUPPLIES FOR FIELDSTONE NEIGHBORS

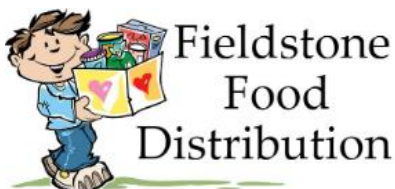
The date to return school supply donations has been extended **to July 27th**. Thank you for your generosity to our neighbors at Fieldstone!
