The Sunday online attendance will have sign-ups for the wide variety of ministries. Signing up is very important as many of these opportunities have special resources that are required. You can also sign-up by emailing Anne Yarnell at anne.yarnell@bsicks.org or Pastor at pastorschultz@bsicks.org.

- 1) **Monday Mornings with the Psalms** – Begin your week with a devotional, meditative reading of the Psalms (this is not a Bible class). There will also be a reading plan so you can begin each day of the week in the Psalms. Although any ESV Bible can be used, the *Crossways Illuminated Scripture Journal: The Psalms* is recommended (Amazon \$10) as it provides blank pages for notes, insights, commentary, etc. This reading group is led by Pastor Schultz and Vicar Hjulberg and meets **Mondays at 7:30am starting September 12th.**
- 2) **Second Saturday for Men** – Join other men in the congregation for breakfast, fellowship, and growth as men. Each month, men will learn what it means to be a man of God in his home, at work, and in his church. Pastor Schultz will cook breakfast and lead the topic each month on the **Second Saturday from 8:00am-9:30am starting September 10th.**
- 3) **Family of Faith Nights** – This weekly night of **Gathering** for Fellowship and **Growing** in the Faith will help better equip us so that we will find more opportunities in our families, at work, among friends and neighbors, and the like to **Go** with the message of salvation and hands for service.

We will meet for these Family of Faith Night on Wednesday evenings starting September 7th. A potluck dinner will be served from 5:30-6:20pm and faith enrichment for all ages will be from 6:30-7:30pm. The descriptions of the classes/activities being offered this fall are listed after the last ministry.

- 4) **Pickleball Fellowship** – Meet every Tuesday night from 6:30pm to 8:30pm in the Fellowship Hall to play Pickleball. Beginners, intermediate and experienced players are all welcome. Pickleball starts **Tuesday October 18th**.
- 5) **Sunday Morning Bible Class** – This is the primary learning and growth experience in a congregation. Every Sunday this summer and fall Pastor Schultz and Vicar Hjulberg will lead a discussion/review of Luther's Small Catechism. **Sundays from 9:30am-10:30am.**
- 6) **Wednesday Men's Bible Breakfast** – This class meets for breakfast at BSLC, fellowship, and to study various books of the Bible. **They are currently studying 1 & 2 Kings and the meet Wednesdays from 6:30am-7:30am.**
- 7) **LifeLight Bible Class** – This is a 9-week Bible class that gives the participant opportunity to be in the Word each day. Participants complete the study at home and then gather together to discuss the study more fully with Pastor Schultz and Vicar Hjulberg. **This class is held on Wednesday morning from 10:00am-12:00pm OR Thursday evening from 6:00pm-8:00pm starting September 14/15th. We will be studying Genesis Part 1.** (Genesis Part 2 will be a 9-week class starting in January).
- 8) **Thursday Morning Ladies Bible Class** – Starting in September, this class for women will be studying a CPH book entitled *Promised Rest: Finding Peace in God's Presence*. Author Michelle Diercks invites you to find His promised rest by studying eight different names and characteristics of God. This class meets via ZOOM each **Thursday beginning September 8th from 9:30am-10:30am.**
- 9) **Faith Alive Group (55+)** – This group is an older adult ministry that meets the third Saturday of the month for food, fun, fellowship, and devotion time.
- 10) **BASIC (Brothers and Sisters in Christ) Bible study** – This is an in-home Bible study group(s) that meets once a month in various member homes for food, fellowship, and study of God's Word.

Family of Faith Nights Specifics:

1. **Parents and Toddlers (Meet from 6:30-7:30pm) (Looking for a Mentor Mom to facilitate)** With Enduring Faith Beginnings: Parents and Toddlers come together to learn about Jesus. Parents will discover practical ways to teach the faith to their children in their homes and have the opportunity to discuss parenting principles.
2. **Pre-K – 4th Grade (Meet from 6:30-7:30pm) (Looking for parent/grandparent facilitators)** Kids will engage in Bible and devotion time, fun and games, mission, and craft projects.
3. **5th & 6th Grade Pre-Confirmation (Meet from 6:00-7:30pm)** This class, led by Vicar Hjulberg, will help kids learn the "Story" of the Bible by walking through God's plan of salvation in the Old Testament.
4. **7th & 8th Grade Confirmation (Meet from 6:00-7:30pm)** This class, led by Pastor Schultz, will cover the Ten Commandments, Lord's Prayer, Confession, and the Lord's Supper as described in Luther's Small Catechism.
5. **High School (Meet from 6:30-7:30pm)** High School kids, led by Pastor Ada, will meet for devotion, fellowship, and games.

6. Adults (Meet from 6:30-7:30pm)

- a. **Jesus: A Study on the Words of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John.** This Bible Study walks through a chronological telling of the life and ministry of Jesus as presented in the 4 Gospels. Each of the 24 sessions are stand-alone 1-hour studies led by Elder, Brian Olson.
- b. **Find Your People.** In a world that's both more connected and more isolating than ever before, we are often tempted to do life alone. Author Jennie Allen draws on fascinating insights from science and history, timeless Biblical truths, and personal stories to help the reader find their people. This book discussion is for women and is facilitated by Dani Olson.
- c. **Demystifying the Proverbs 31 Woman** This Bible Study is an authoritative yet inviting discussion of Proverbs 31 in terms of language, history, purpose, and application. Readers will come away with a sense of renewal and affirmation—and a keener understanding of the biblical example of the Proverbs 31 Woman. This is a Bible Class for women and is facilitated by Lisa Gruhn.
- d. **Adult Bell Choir Rehearsal.** This group meets in the sanctuary and prepare music to edify worship on Sundays. **NOTE: Adult vocal choir** also meets in the sanctuary from 7:30-8:30pm. Both choirs are led by Lauran Delancy.
