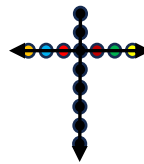

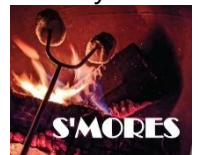

In the Apostle Paul's second letter to the Corinthians, he devoted two chapters to encourage giving. One of the giving truths that he encourages is to give sacrificially. Paul wrote about the Macedonians, "For they gave according to their means, as I can testify, and beyond their means, of their own accord" (2 Corinthians 8:3). It does not matter how much we give, because for each person that would be different. But it does matter that it should cost us something. After all, if God's giving cost him even the life of his only Son, how could our giving ever be cheap? That does not make any sense. A faithful manager of God's resources will make attempts to give sacrificially.

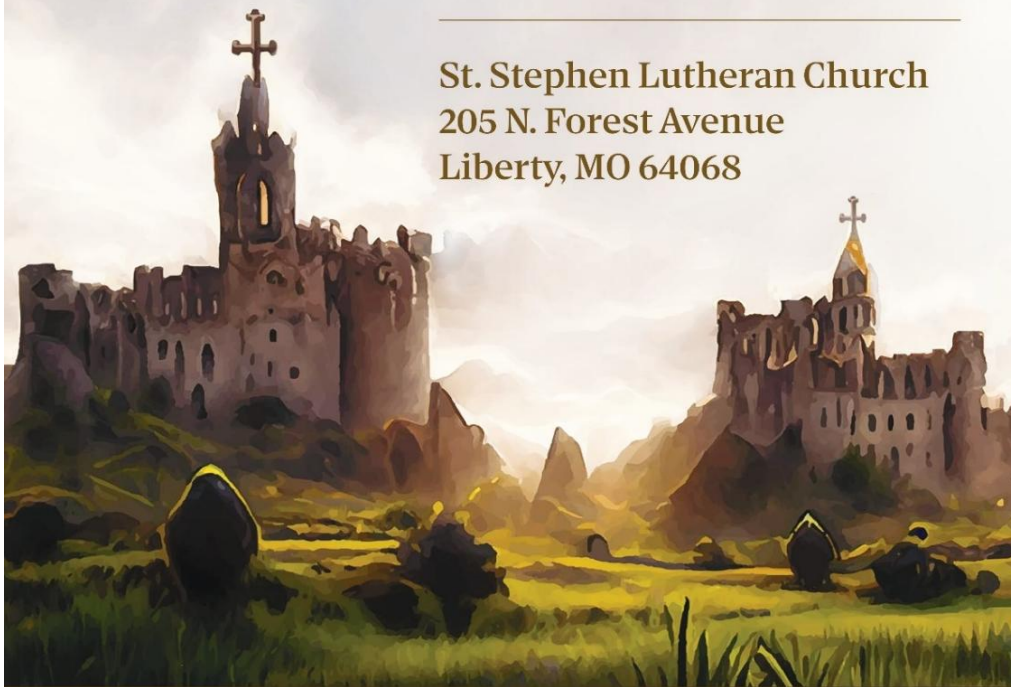

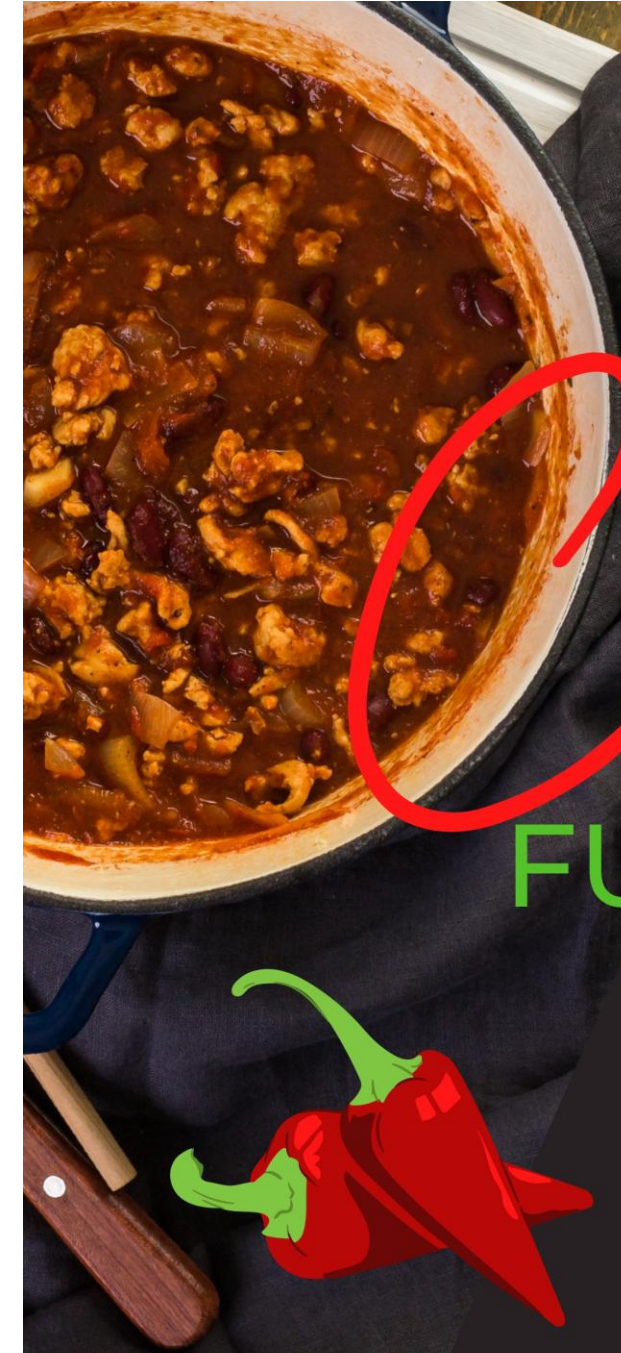
