Christian Woman Attacked by Family - Sierra Leone

Georgieta's family worshiped demonic spirits in an area where human sacrifice is said to still occur. When Georgieta became a Christian, she refused to participate in her family's occultic rituals, so her parents threw her out of the house. Homeless,

Georgieta lived with a pastor and his family. Later, Georgieta's father became sick, and her family planned



to ritually sacrifice her, hoping it would heal her

father. Georgieta escaped, but when her father later died of the illness, Georgieta's mother blamed her for his death. She then attacked and tried to kill Georgieta. Afterward, Georgieta fled from her hometown. She now lives in a safe location where she is receiving biblical teaching and training to become a seamstress.

HVAC CONGREGATION UPDATE #4

- Progress the week of September 23rd:
 - The excavation and pouring of the sound wall footers was completed, however, due to soil compaction issues the depth of the footers had to be increased.
 - The HVAC contractor continued to install ductwork in the lower level for the 25-ton units.
- Planned the week of September 30th:
 - HVAC contractor to continue installing duct work. We should complete installation of the duct for the north 25-ton unit.
 - Excavate and install conduit and gas service to the new RTU location.
 - Mobilize CMU contractor to lay the first row of cement block laid to facilitate the pouring of sound wall/RTU slab.
- Pre-suit mediation meeting was held on Friday, September 27th with no settlement. A second

pre-suit mediation meeting is scheduled for November 15th.

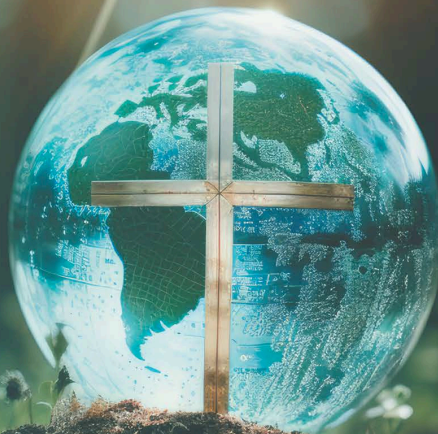

Philippians Conference

Saturday, November 23, 2024

Hope Lutheran Church, Shawnee, KS, in partnership with LCMS National Mission – Stewardship will host a **Philippians Conference**. The conference will be facilitated by the Rev. Dr. Nathan Meador, SWD Mission Executive and LCMS National Mission Stewardship Specialist. Dr. Meador co-authored the work *Stewardship for the Care of Souls* and has been part of LCMS National Mission – Stewardship since 2013.

What is a Philippians Conference? The workshop is based on Paul's words in Philippians Chapter 1. In that chapter, and throughout the whole book of Philippians, we see how all the leadership of the congregation is working together in the realm of stewardship: Paul, Timothy, deacons, overseers and lay "partners in the Gospel" are all mentioned within just the first three verses.

The Philippians Conference gathers pastors and lay leaders from the congregational level to spend a day together looking at the theology and practice of stewardship. The goal of the event is to ground congregational stewardship on the solid foundation of Scripture and Confession. The session will also investigate the need for the local congregation to assess, strengthen and even change their local stewardship culture. The highlights of these events are that the congregation gets a fresh perspective on stewardship and leaves the event with one or two action items to put into practice immediately.

Who Should Attend?

- Pastors – This is critical since the teaching of stewardship is part of the whole counsel of God.
- Elders and other elected leaders - Stewardship is a spiritual and pastoral care issue.
- Other members of the congregation – EVERY human being is a steward by virtue of Creation and every child of God is a steward of the Gospel by virtue of their baptismal identity.
