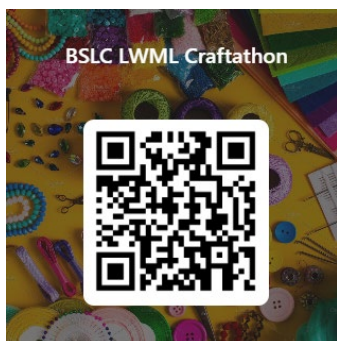

FAITH ALIVE

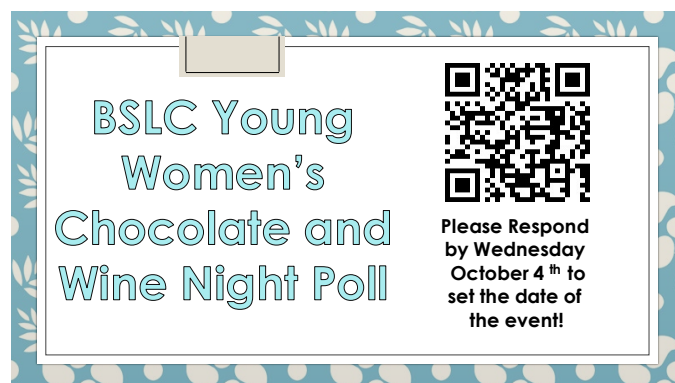
