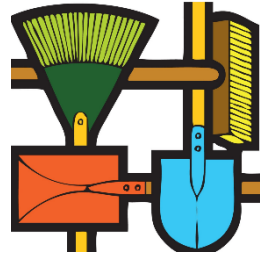

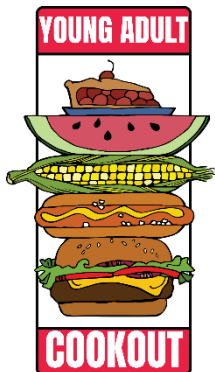
FAITH ALIVE
