### Shelter Fundamentals and Shelter Simulation Courses

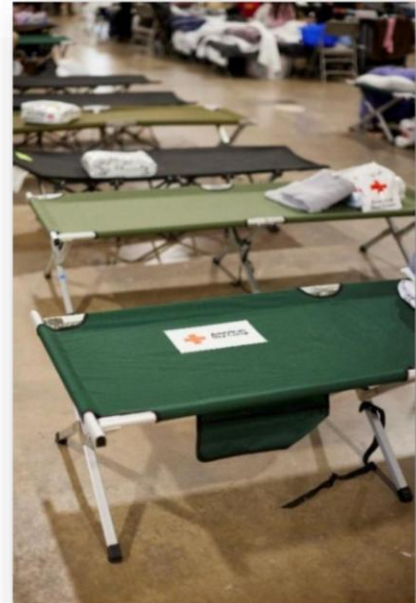
