HVAC CONGREGATION UPDATE #8 Completed Work

- Completed re-installing ceiling lights and associated sensor in the lower level.
- Completed installing the outlet for powering a temporary heater for the FH.
- Completed removal of lights and installing temporary lighting in the northwest and southwest FH closets.
- Completed installation of lower-level ductwork.
- Continue removing duct work in the upper level of the FH.
- Conducted a site visit with the control subcontractor to determine scope of work and set installation plan for HVAC control system.
- Completed laying the 12-inch concrete block for the sound wall.
- Completed all grout pours.
- Completed cutting out FH exterior wall for upper-level ductwork.
- Completed final lower-level ceiling grid and border ceiling panels
- Installed four (4) smoke detector sensors on lower-level ductwork.
- City of Olathe conducted and approved the lower level for the above ceiling inspection.

Work for the Week of November 25th

- Install a temporary heater in FH hall.
- Install power receptacle for HVAC control panel.
- Tentative on starting brick and stucco facade on concrete block wall.
- Install wall and control joint seals.
- Take delivery of initial upper-level ductwork.
- Start installation of upper-level ductwork.
