January 2021 Construction Summary Report

2021 Thanks be to God. We start January with optimism and determination. Snow on the ground, the water main extension work re-started and is near completion as of 30th, only final testing and inspection by City of Olathe for the first week in February. Mass excavation continues. We did attain our goal of completion of the relocation of the existing site utilities on January 18th. This was achieved with great effort, coordination and collaboration of Evergy, Google Fiber, Cohorst, Electric Associates, BSLC Staff and volunteers to be able to shut the facility completely down on January 18th, MLK Day of Service, when no children or staff were in the building. The utility and craft worked efficiently together and shut the building down at 9:00 AM and turned it all back on at 2:25 PM. This completion of the utility relocation will free the site up for the rest of the mass excavation and storm water system construction. We did complete the civil preparation of the subgrade for main building pad as far as we could prior to the existing utilities being abandon, this civil work continues into February. Storm Water System materials

were delivered to site. The Site team met with the retaining wall contractor BC Hardscapes, LLC and Cohorst Enterprises, Inc. on the 27th for a preconstruction meeting to coordinate work planned to start in February. We also had an initial meeting with the steel fabricator, Needham DBS and their subcontractor for erection to prepare for pre-construction in March. Weather hampered progress some but less than expected for January.



Goals for February:

- Completion of the subgrade and LVC fill work for Fellowship Building and Maintenance Building.
- Mobilize BC Hardscape, LLC and Bottorff Construction, Inc. for retaining wall and concrete scope.
- Continue mass grading for parking lots and storm water detention structure.
- Addition of Mark Fintel, Laborers for Christ, to prepare for work to be executed by BSLC and LFC volunteers, which is the Maintenance Building above grade work and available interior work of the Fellowship building.
- Prepare for steel delivery and erection.
- Continue and near completion of re-bidding of remainder of contractors, equipment and material suppliers for the project.
- Develop and solidify project schedule for the remainder of the project now that known uncontrolled impediments to progress have been address. Now we only have to address the unknown ones.

ASH WEDNESDAY is coming up on Wednesday, February 17. Service is at 7:00pm. Ash Wednesday's theme is "A Call to Return."


DEVOTIONAL BOOKLETS AVAILABLE
