PARISH ANNOUNCEMENTS

HVAC CONGREGATION UPDATE #3

- Progress the week of September 9th:
 - Started excavating to prepare for the HVAC RTU concrete mounting pads.
 - Successfully re-designed the HVAC RTU mounting pads to better match the construction site conditions, due to the 10" building drain being in the way and unfavorable soil conditions.
 - Contractor completed the backfill and prepared the site for sound wall footer excavation.
 - Successfully directional bored the gas line on the east side of the building.
 - Completed duct work removal on the north lower-level hallway.
- Planned the week of September 16th:
 - Start excavating and pouring sound wall footers.
 - Start to re-install and take delivery of the additional duct work in the lower level.
 - Mark out new openings on the north side of Fellowship Hall in preparation to have the openings cut out by contractor.
 - Tentatively scheduled to start window removal and cutting openings in the North FH wall.
 - All contractors meeting for Wednesday September 18th at 8:00 AM to review schedule and coordination due to change in HVAC RTU pad redesign.
- Pre-suit mediation has been confirmed for September 27th.

BSLC BLOOD DRIVE RESULTS

Our BSLC blood drive team would like to thank every one of you who came on Sunday to support our very successful blood drive! Our donors and volunteers are the spirit behind that success, and the glue that holds the process together! Our donations surpassed our goal and have positively contributed to the urgent need for blood in our communities at this time! The



Red Cross Team is so very grateful and says thank you to you all!

The results:

- 50 donors registered, 15 of whom were able to walk in without appointments.
- Of those 50, 5 donors gave Power Red donations, which count as 2 pints.
- 37 donors gave Whole Blood donations.
- 7 donors were not eligible (This is expected. Keep trying! It sometimes takes a few attempts!)
- We continue to build our base! 23 donors were first time donors!!!
- Final number of pints is 47! The Community Club Program will be donating \$470 to our Family of Faith evenings!

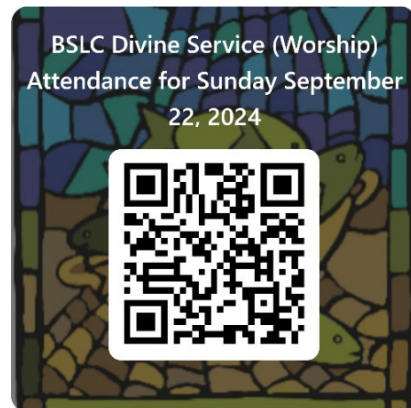

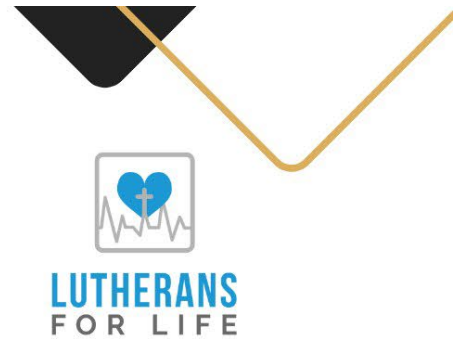

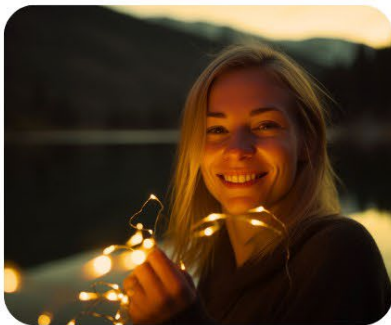
