SUMMER SUNDAY SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

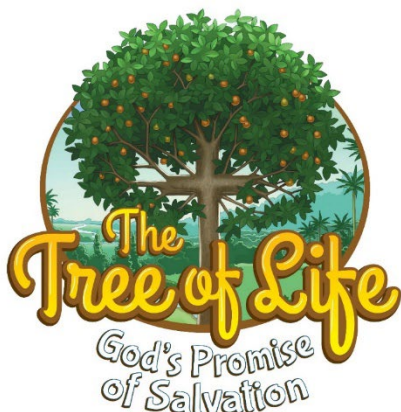
