PRISON MINISTRY

LHM-Liberia visited two prisons in Grand Bassa County and Bomi County to present graduation certificates to inmates who recently completed the ministry center's **Bible Correspondence Courses**. During these visits, the LHM team encouraged the prisoners to look to Christ for their wellbeing, reflect on their past, and embrace the hope of a renewed life with Jesus at the center. The LHM staff also had the opportunity to meet with the prison personnel, to strengthen relationships and to share encouragement in the Lord.

- The LHM team hosted a youth outreach rally at a local school, where 198 students participated and heard the Good News of Jesus Christ.

EQUIPPING THE SAINTS WORKSHOP

The ministry center team conducted an **Equipping the Saints** workshop at a local church in Gipo, focusing on empowering church leaders and members with practical evangelism skills. The seminar brought together leaders and members from five congregations, equipping them with the knowledge and confidence needed to share their faith and to support other church workers in fulfilling the Great Commission, as instructed in Matthew 28:19-20.

Participants received training in new and effective evangelism techniques, helping them communicate the Gospel message with clarity and assurance. The workshop gathered 71 church workers from across Liberia, creating a meaningful time of learning, fellowship, and spiritual strengthening.

Ministry Impact

Felecia is a mother of three who has experienced a variety of struggles in her life. When she received a brochure detailing the programs and resources offered by LHM-Liberia, she was interested in learning more about their Dorcas Sewing Class since providing financially for her family has never been easy. This program empowers single mothers to learn practical skills like operating a sewing machine, taking measurements, and preparing patterns. In addition to skills development, the Dorcas Sewing Class also fosters a sense of community among the participants, many who hear the Gospel for the first time during the ongoing classes. "This class means everything to me," Felecia shared with quiet determination. "Through sewing, I can feed my children, send them to school, and hopefully one day stand on my own with my own business".
