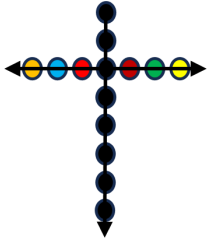

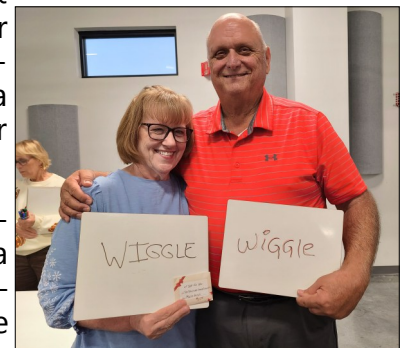

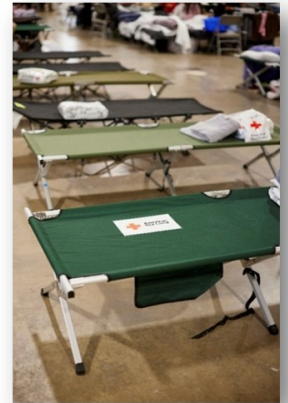
TRAIN NOW FOR THE MOMENTS THAT MATTER Shelter Fundamentals and Shelter Simulation Courses

When disaster strikes – the first need for those affected is a safe place to stay. Providing that safe haven while our community members move through their recovery is a critical part of their well-being.

The American Red Cross Shelter Fundamentals and Shelter Simulation courses provide a basic understanding of what a safe and effective shelter looks like – and how to best meet the needs of those who need us most in those initial hours.



Target audience: This training is of benefit to employees, community volunteers, Community Organizations Active in Disasters (COAD) and Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) volunteers who want to assist with activities and tasks in working at a shelter. Register Today!

WOMEN'S MINISTRY



On Saturday, October 18, five women from Beautiful Savior attended the LWML Kansas City CrossRoads Zone Fall Event at First Lutheran Church in Paola. The program speaker was Pastor Jacob Mueller from Hope Lutheran Church in Shawnee. Pastor Mueller studied in Pretoria, South Africa for 6 months prior to attending Concordia Seminary in

St. Louis. Through the friendships he made during his time in South Africa, he has been able to return to Africa several times to teach at the Lutheran seminary established in Uganda. Uganda is one of the 54 countries in Africa and is roughly the size of Oregon, with a population of about 40 million people. There were no Lutheran churches in Uganda as of 1994; today, there are more than 100 congregations with approximately 50,000 members. There are currently 20 Lutheran schools in South Sudan. The people are excited to hear the God's Word and to receive His gifts! Uganda has 40 official language groups, but English is the predominant language used for business and education. Pastor Mueller shared that this is why English copies of the Bible, Lutheran Service Book, Small Catechism, other Lutheran publications, both used and new, are such a blessing to the Ugandan church. Whenever he travels to Uganda, he fills his suitcases with these Lutheran publications so they can be distributed to students at the seminary and to congregations throughout the country. Pastor Mueller plans to return to Uganda again this winter. A freewill offering was collected to help cover the costs of purchasing and transporting books. Thank you to everyone at BSLC who donated food items for the Gifts from the Heart collection for My Father's House in Paola.

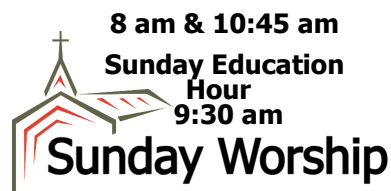
