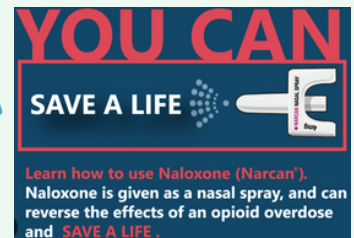

## Free Narcan Nasal Spray



Free Narcan/Naloxone nasal spray that is used to treat Fentanyl/opioid overdoses is available at the Johnson County Health Dept. The office is located at the NW corner of Ridgeview and 119<sup>th</sup> street in Olathe. Walk in the health services door. There is a cabinet on the wall. Turn the key to open the door and help yourself. Check the expiration date on the box as the ones they give away are usually only good for less than a year. There may also be some available at the Olathe public libraries. They were working on getting that set up in conjunction with the health dept. Families with teens & young adults are encouraged to be prepared. The nasal spray is easy to administer and there is no risk to the "patient" if it is used and not needed.
