MISSION PROJECT Our mission project this month is for ten young adults in the ReStart Adopt-A-Youth Foster House here in Olathe. We will receive items or monetary donations to purchase items to make Valentine's Day for these 18-21 year-olds a little more special, such as: Target, Walmart, and QuickTrip gift cards, restaurant gift cards (McDonalds and Chik-fil-A are popular choices), hot chocolate packets, gloves, socks, microwave popcorn, chips, snacks, candy. (Currently only one has food allergies to dairy, eggs, wheat.) There are four guys and six girls. Aleesa Lennon, the case worker, presented at our January LWML Zoom meeting about this program. Gift cards and monetary donations can be placed in the locked wood box on top of the wood donation box in the narthex - or mailed to the church office, marked LWML. Donations of items can be placed in the wood box. We would like to have everything by February 7. Donations will be monitored and stored for delivery before Feb. 14. Thank you in advance for supporting these young people as they work toward being safe, healthy, and independent.
