Instructions for Communing

We use <u>continuous kneeling tables</u> for Holy Communion. The congregation will be ushered forward to kneel. You will receive the Body of Jesus from the Pastors and then the Blood of Jesus from the Elder/Vicar. You may receive either from the common cup or the individual cup. When you have sufficiently meditated, stand, reverence the altar, and return to your seat. Those not communing will receive a blessing from the pastor.

Non-alcoholic white wine in located in the center of each tray and should only be used by those with medical conditions prohibiting the use of wine.

Gluten-free wafers are available from the pastor when you come forward.



VOICE OF THE MARTYRS PRAYER REQUEST

Pastor's Name on ISIS Hit List - Turkey

On Sunday, January 28, two masked gunmen entered a Catholic church in Istanbul during a service and randomly shot and killed a 52-year-old man. The self-proclaimed Islamic State (ISIS) claimed responsibility. Turkish police quickly arrested two suspects with ties to ISIS and later arrested 25 more after raiding numerous locations. Afterwards, police contacted a pastor of a rapidly growing church in another part of Turkiye and told him that his name was on an ISIS hit list. "This pastor has been threatened by ultra-nationalist Turks many times, but this was the first time that he sounded worried," said a front-line worker. Turkish police offered to protect the pastor and encouraged him to set up security cameras. "We can't pray for the elimination of persecution," said the front-worker, "but we can pray that believers will be strengthened and recognize these things are happening because of the growth of the church."
