November Summary Report

Early part of the month of November was spent jumping the hurdles and responding to City of Olathe and Johnson County requirements to attain the necessary approvals, authorizations, predecessor permit to be authorized to actually break ground and move dirt. But the efforts of your design professionals, field staff and contractors prevailed on November 10, 2020.

While these efforts with the, "Authorities Having Jurisdiction" (AHJ), the field staff continued efforts with the Utility companies, Evergy, ATMOS Energy and Google Fiber to coordinate the relocation of this infrastructure to allow the required mass excavation and grading for the sewer line, water lines and main extension, and communication infrastructure to planned locations to support the addition.

We had planned to physically attain the BUILDING PERMIT then start on November 10th but Murphy's law prevailed and after a week of good weather it rained enough to prevent our efforts but the following day ... Veteran's Day clearing, grubbing and sewer line excavation from the southwest corner of the addition to the manhole on the south side of the facility entrance drive commence.

Now that actual construction started the field staff turned attention to coordination of inspections, quality assurance and procurement efforts. City of Olathe Sewer Line inspectors and Terracon Consultant (our special inspection consultant) were notified and scheduled. Work has proceeded well, even with the anticipated rock formations that required larger equipment and determined efforts to clear the way for new construction. The construction site coordinated with the Preschool and staff for closure of the main drive access on Friday, November 13th, all went well.

November 16th ATMOS Energy (Gas Company) moved on site a week early to begin relocation of their line to the north and east perimeter of the site. Good management Northern Pipeline allowed this task to be completed smoothly prior to Thanksgiving Day. November 23rd the installation of the water line started at the south side of the site to across the front of the playground providing much interesting observation by our preschoolers. Additionally, Electrical Associates began the infrastructure installation to relocated the Evergy power and Google Fiber utility services on site. Evergy began their boring under Black Bob to meet up with the onsite work to supply the new electric power service; this work will continue into December.

In December we will continue the mass excavation and fill work to prepare for the building foundations, complete the utility relocations and begin rough grade work for the parking lot, retaining wall, new entrance off Black Bob and south main drive. Scheduling for the start of building foundations. The job site will be closed starting end of the day December 23rd through start of the day January 4th 2021. Pray to God that in 2021; His will be done and we will be granted SAFE, efficient and quality construction to His glory. And all God's people say "AMEN!"
