## **STATEMENT OF FAITH**

Martin Luther's explanation of the Second Article of the Apostle's Creed with music from *Of the Father's Love Begotten (LSB 384)* 

- All: I believe that Jesus Christ, true God, begotten of the Father from eternity, and also true man, born of the virgin Mary is my Lord.
- All Sing: Of the Father's love begotten Ere the worlds began to be, He is Alpha and Omega, He the source, the ending He, Of things that are, that have been, And that future years shall see Evermore and evermore.

- C Lord, have mercy.



## Instructions for Communing

We use <u>continuous kneeling tables</u> for Holy Communion. The congregation will be ushered forward to kneel. You will receive the Body of Jesus from the Pastors and then the Blood of Jesus from the Elder/Vicar. You may receive either from the common cup or the individual cup. When you have sufficiently meditated, stand, reverence the altar, and return to your seat. Those not communing will receive a blessing from the pastor.

**Non-alcoholic white wine** in located in the center of each tray and should be used only by those with medical conditions prohibiting the use of wine.

Gluten-free wafers are available; please indicate your need to the pastor at the table.
