LWML Mission Donations - Mission Grant #1

Convention delegates from LWML groups across Kansas selected the mission grants we will support throughout the next year and a half. Now, it's time to start funding them! The first one is for Or-

phan Grain Train (OGT), operating in St. Petersburg, Russia, to provide health care needs for children in the orphanag-

es. This grant funds basic daily needs such as diapers, wipes, and medical items like bandaids. There are 60 plus Russian Orphanages that OGT assists. The Russian Government allocates money, but the local budget only allows for approximately one diaper a day for each orphan. Money is disbursed through OGT to appointed Russian workers that run the or-

phanages. Please consider donating. Cash and checks can be put in the LWML Mite Box at church. Checks can also be mailed to Karen Benz,

Treasurer. If you are looking for an online option, secure donations can be made through the Give Plus app, select Kansas District LWML for donation options.

Kansas District LWML Awards God's Gracious Gift Fund

One of the recipients of an LWML grant from the God's Gracious Gift Fund was the Orphan Grain

Train Relief Center of rural Herington. The group was awarded \$2,000 to cover trans-



portation costs for the shipping container used to store and transport items for OGT. The container is located at St. John's Lutheran Church at Lyons Creek. With a container on site, boxes can be packed directly into the container without the need for additional transfer costs. The former school house is used to collect, sort, and box the donations. Once the container is full, OGT picks it up for transport to their warehouse in Norfolk, Nebraska, and replaces it with an empty unit. Marci Brockmeier's mother,



Mary, and aunt, Emilee Morgan, are part of the weekly volunteers at the site. LWML Kansas District President Kim Burdett and District Planner Eden Keefe were there, along with four other LWML district leaders, to present the check. 
